3 **Discussed**

- a. Matters arising from previous minutes (not covered below) None.

- iii. KEVICC It remains the intention to contact the college to provide a copy of the Aecom report and commend a comprehensive development plan. However, it was not clear whether this would be best addressed to the college or the

executive of the Multi Academy Trust that has the ultimate control over decisions.

- iv. Civic Hall it was noted that the application has been withdrawn.
 - g. Matters raised by members/others two items relating to Fischowters Lane and a cycle route under the rail bridge at Totnes.
- h. AOB Jim gave update on the Dartington Transition Homes development. Following the withdrawal of finance for the development from Triodos Bank, negotiations are progressing for the sale of the site to a housing association.
